Request for Expressions of Interest

This request for expressions of interest by JFK Millennium Partners ("JMP") is regarding Security Screening Checkpoint Equipment for the Terminal 6 Redevelopment Project ("Project"), located at John F. Kennedy ("JFK") International Airport in Queens, NY. This document serves as the first stage to JMP's upcoming Request for Proposal ("RFP"). All parties interested in submitting proposals are encouraged to submit their expression of interest to JMP via the format and method outlined below. Parties that express interest will receive further instructions via BuildingConnected on how to proceed with the proposal process.

Project: JFK Terminal 6 (T6) Redevelopment

Procurement Name and Number: RFP-015

Brief Description of Work:

Scope One - Security Checkpoint Lane Equipment

Manufacture and deliver seven Checkpoint Property Screening System (CPSS) lanes for use at the TSA checkpoint at JFK Terminal 6. The procurement consists of six "CPSS Full-Size" units and one "CPSS Base" unit. Equipment must utilize computed tomography (CT) equipment and be listed on the TSA Acceptable Capability List. Procurement to include any associated ancillary equipment and/or test kits required for acceptance and use by the TSA.

Scope Two - Advanced Imaging Technology

Manufacture and deliver four Advanced Imaging Technology (AIT) units for the detection of metallic and nonmetallic anomalies concealed on passengers for use at the TSA checkpoint at JFK Terminal 6. Equipment must be listed on the TSA Acceptable Capability List. Procurement to include any associated ancillary equipment and/or test kits required for acceptance and use by the TSA.

Scope Three - Integration *(note this procurement may follow later)*

Provide installation and integration services for the deployment of checkpoint technology and other equipment at the TSA checkpoint at JFK Terminal 6. Services will include (but may not be limited to):

- Final design and TSA approval of checkpoint layout, including planning for hard barriers around and between lanes
- Installation, testing, commissioning, and certification of seven CPSS lanes (including remote viewing room) and four AIT systems
- Provision and installation of equipment deemed "non-competitive" by the TSA (where only one authorized provider exists on the TSA Acceptable Capability List) in a quantity deemed required by the TSA, including:
 - Boarding pass scanners
 - Bottled Liquid Scanners
 - Credential Authentication Technology
 - Explosive Trace Detectors
 - Enhanced Metal Detectors
- Provision and installation of hard barriers around and between lanes as identified in the final approved design

Proponents must have demonstrated experience in the installation, commissioning, testing and certification of the chosen equipment and be authorized and certified by the TSA for carrying out these services.
