- **Completed Q4 2022**



# JFK TRANSFORMATION

**Private investment = \$15 Billion**

**PANYNJ investment = \$3.9 Billion**

**Leveraging public dollars at a 4:1 ratio**

***Total JFK investment = \$18.9 Billion***





## JFK Transformation

---

- The terminals being replaced were built over 50 years ago – outdated and undersized
- All of these changes are part of a thoughtful, integrated JFK vision plan -- just like LGA
- LGA was \$8 billion and this is a \$19 billion overhaul – massive changes coming to JFK
- Two new world-class terminals anchoring the north/south sides and major expansion to T4



# JFK Transformation – New Terminal 1

- Enormous, modern terminal with spacious ceilings to serve dozens of major international airlines and provide NY sense of place
- State of the art technology, best-in-class sustainability practices, appealing public art, and popular local New York concessions
- Project will create more than 10,000 new jobs, including 6,000 construction jobs and billions in local and MWBE contracts
- Majority of New gates opening in 2026
- World Class

## JFK Transformation – New Terminal 6

- Spacious, airy floor-to-ceiling windows and high ceilings connected to existing Terminal 5 (JetBlue) with a NY sense of place
- State of the art Security screening and check in facilities
- Locally-based restaurateurs, craft beverage options and Taste of NY stores
- Inspiring public art by New York-based artists and architectural elements depicting New York landmarks
- Project will create 4,000 jobs, including 1,800 jobs in construction
- First gates opening in 2026
- World Class

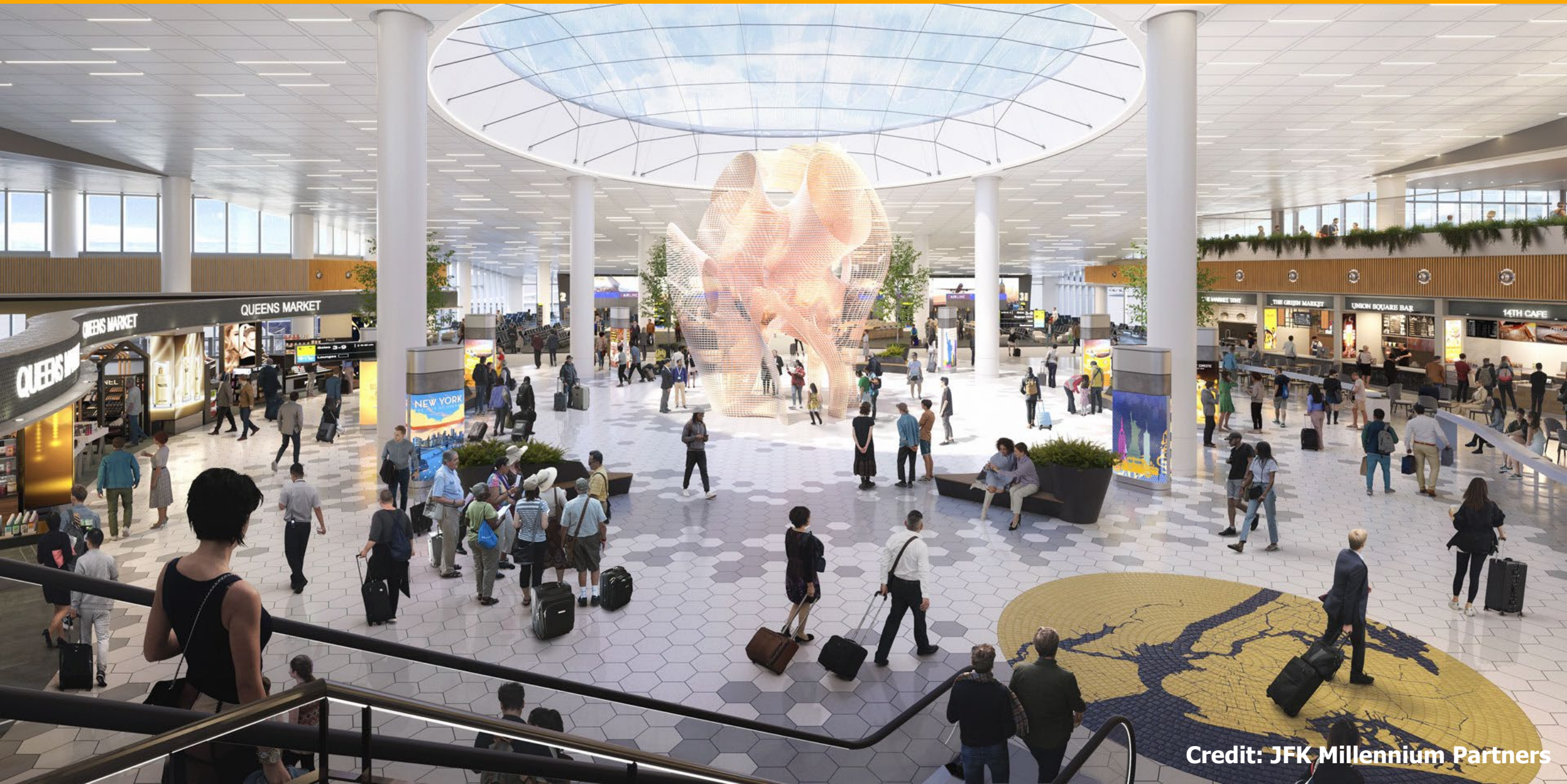

## JFK Transformation – The Next Few Years

- Our experience at LGA will inform our JFK strategy -- very proactive
- A full 24/7 Airport Operations Center monitoring traffic
- Temporary changes to pick up areas for shared rides and taxis
- AirTrain impacts, including a 7 month closure of T1 station starting 5/1
- We recognize that construction presents challenges for passengers
- There will be inconveniences – we will work hard to minimize them
- We apologize in advance and ask travelers for their patience
- If you have traveled through LGA recently we hope you'd agree: it's all worth it

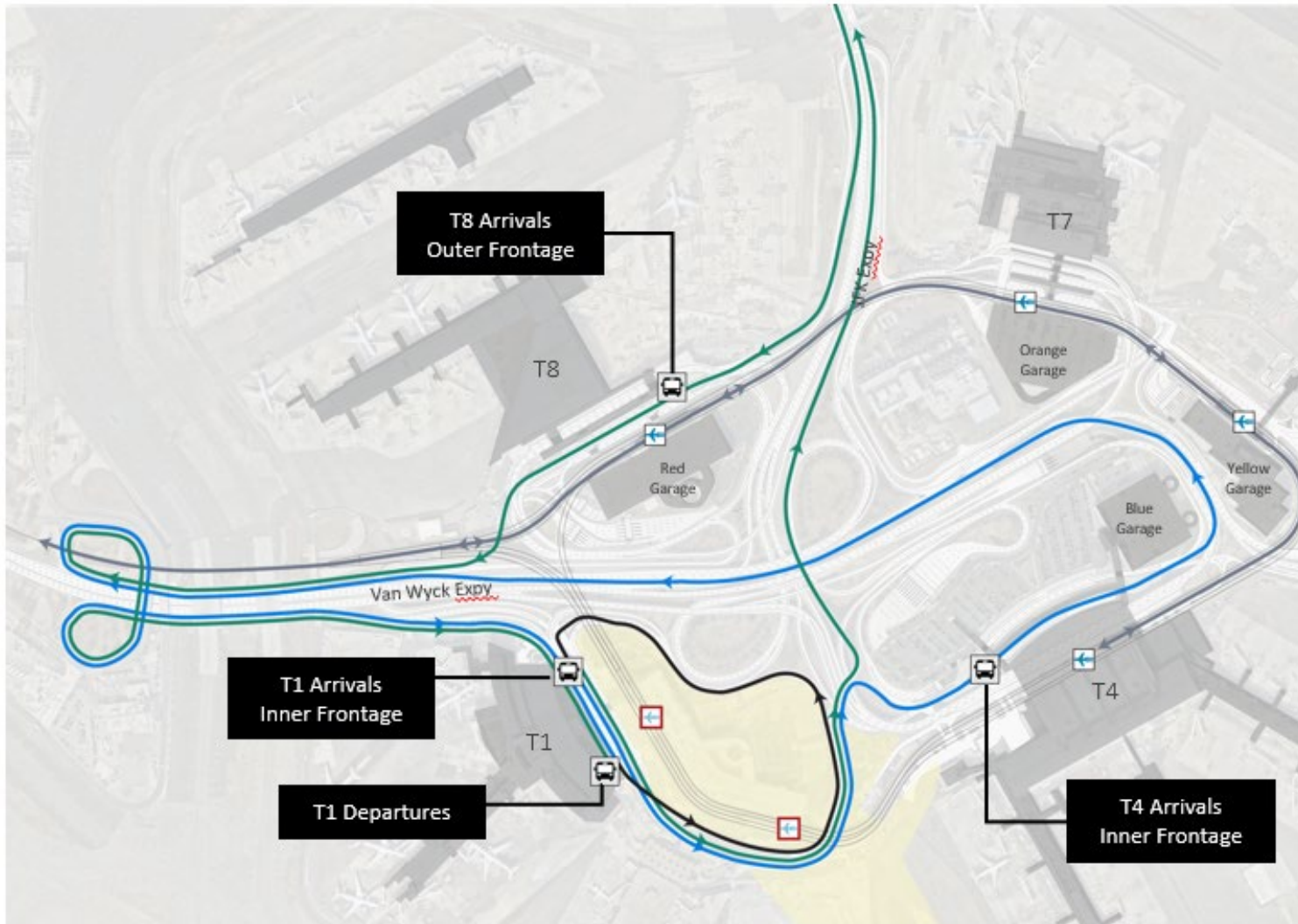

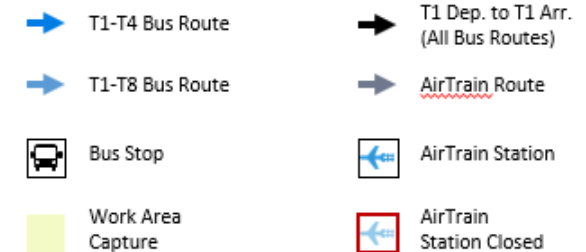




# Terminal 1 | AirTrain Station Closed Starting May 1



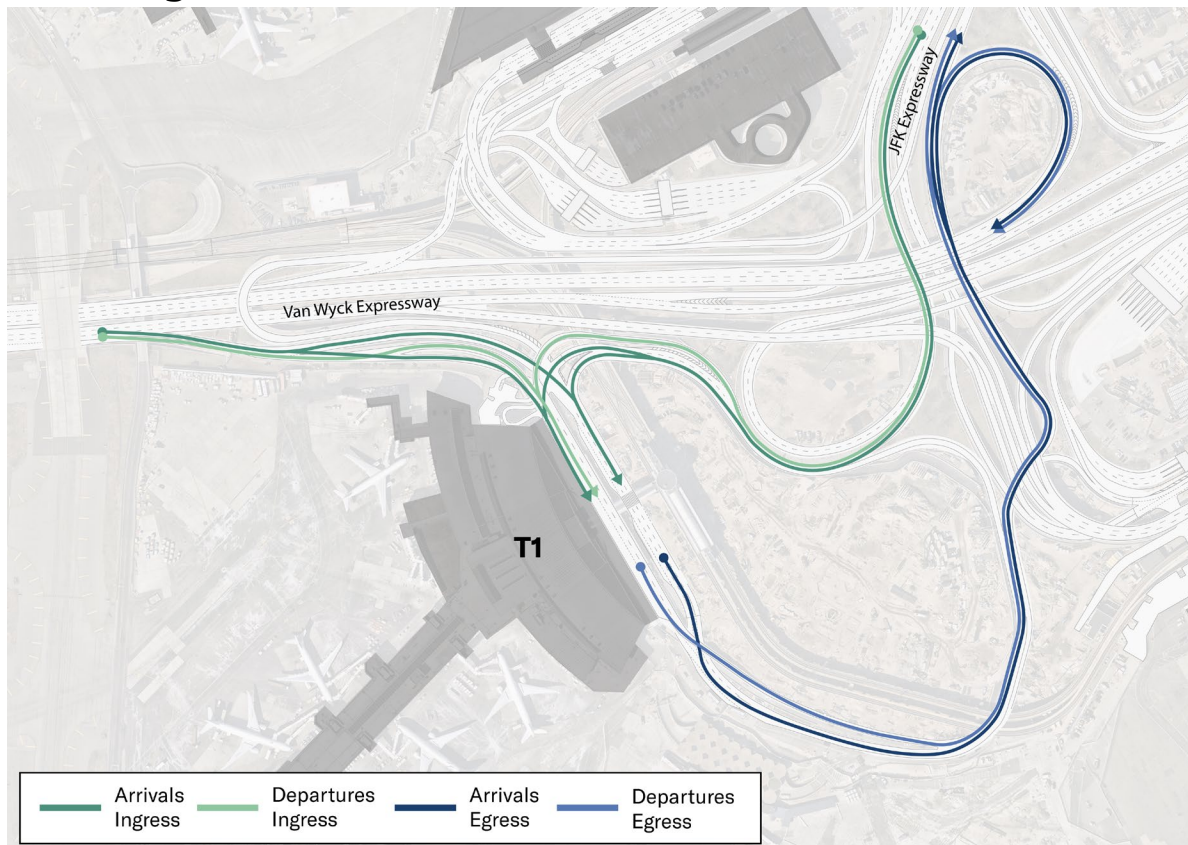
- Approx. 7 Month Duration due to new Terminal 1 construction
- AirTrain access unaffected for all other terminals
- Buses Provided:
- Primary bus route: Terminal 8 - Terminal 1 (24 hours)  
Secondary bus: Terminal 4 – Terminal 1 (9 am – 11 pm)



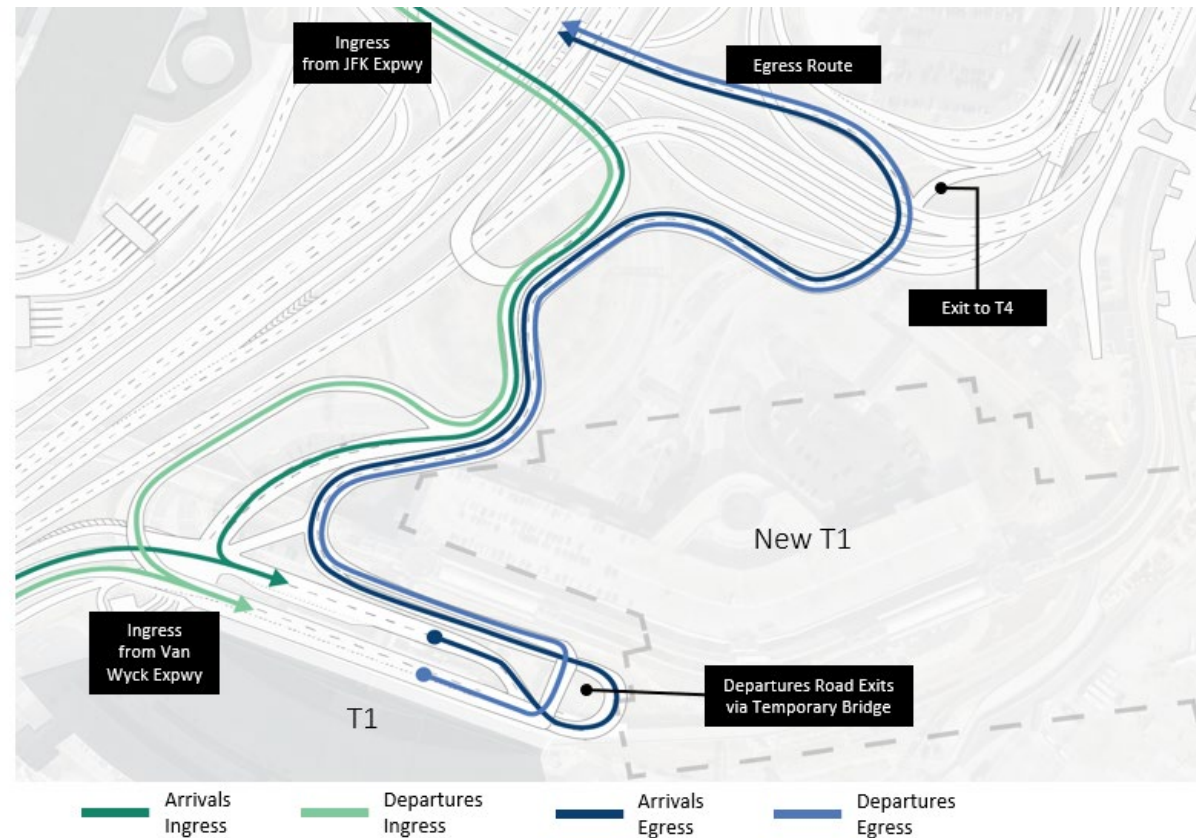

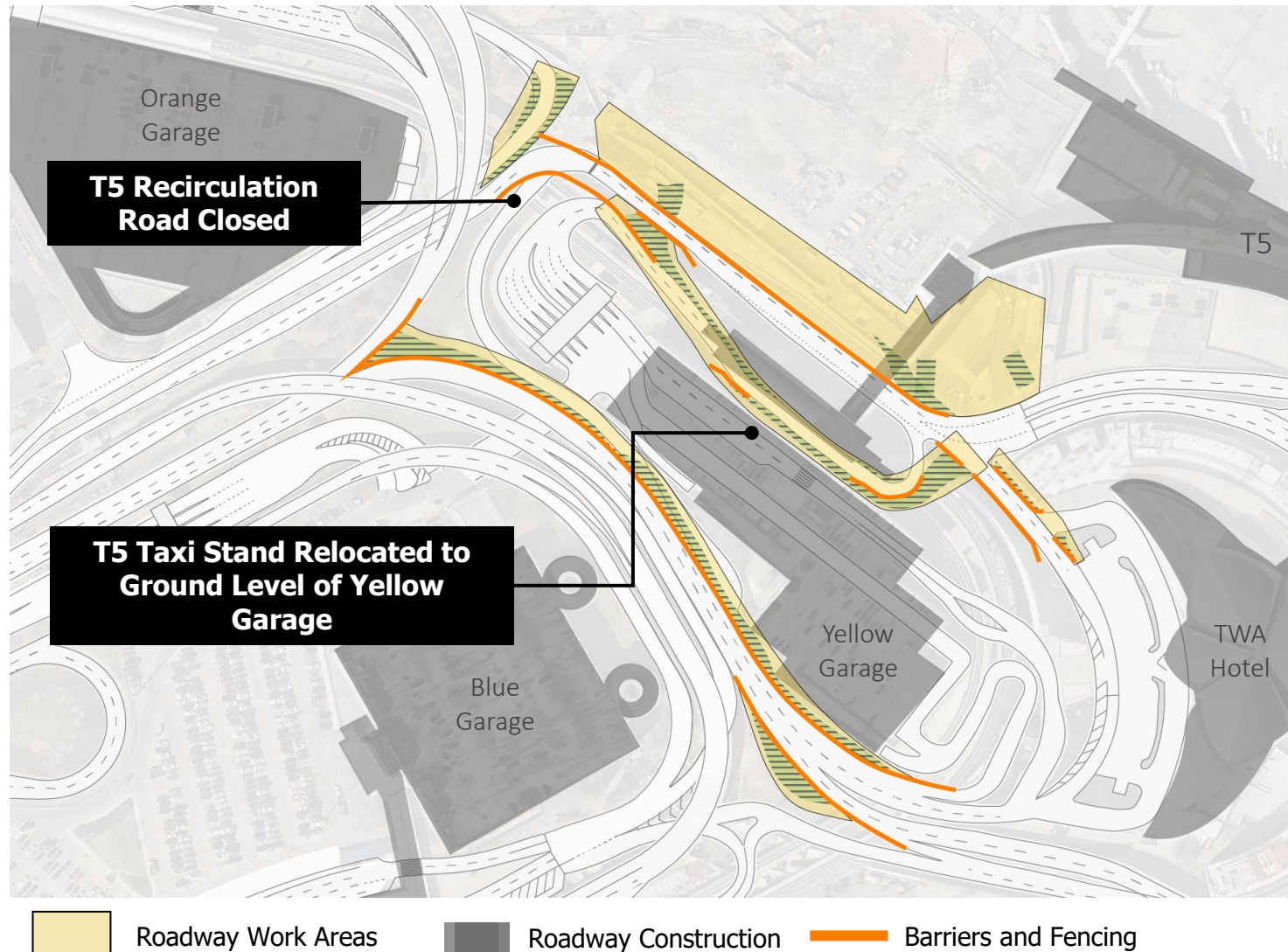

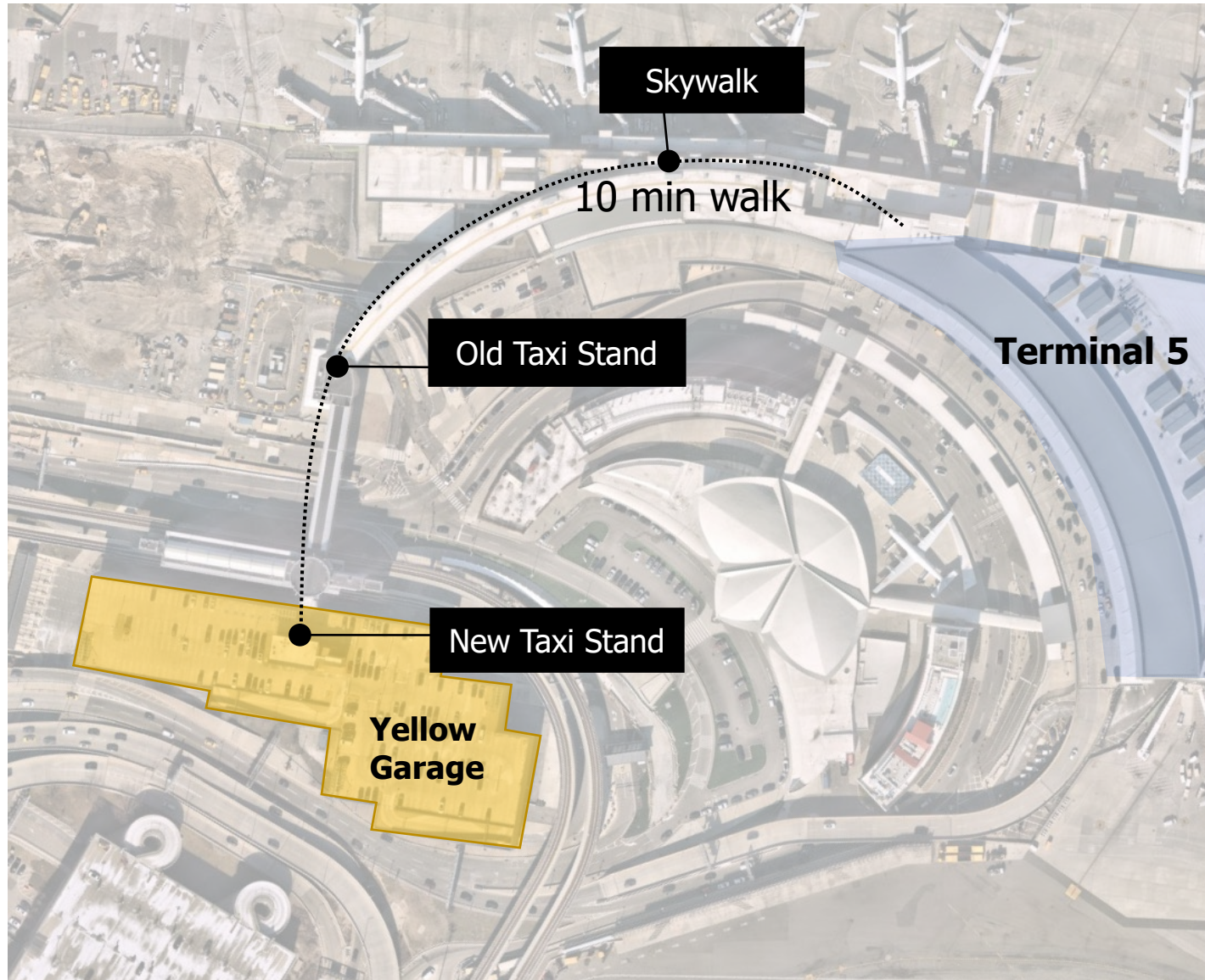
## Terminal 5/6 | Upcoming Roadway Changes

- Early May: Terminal 5 Recirculation Road to be permanently closed



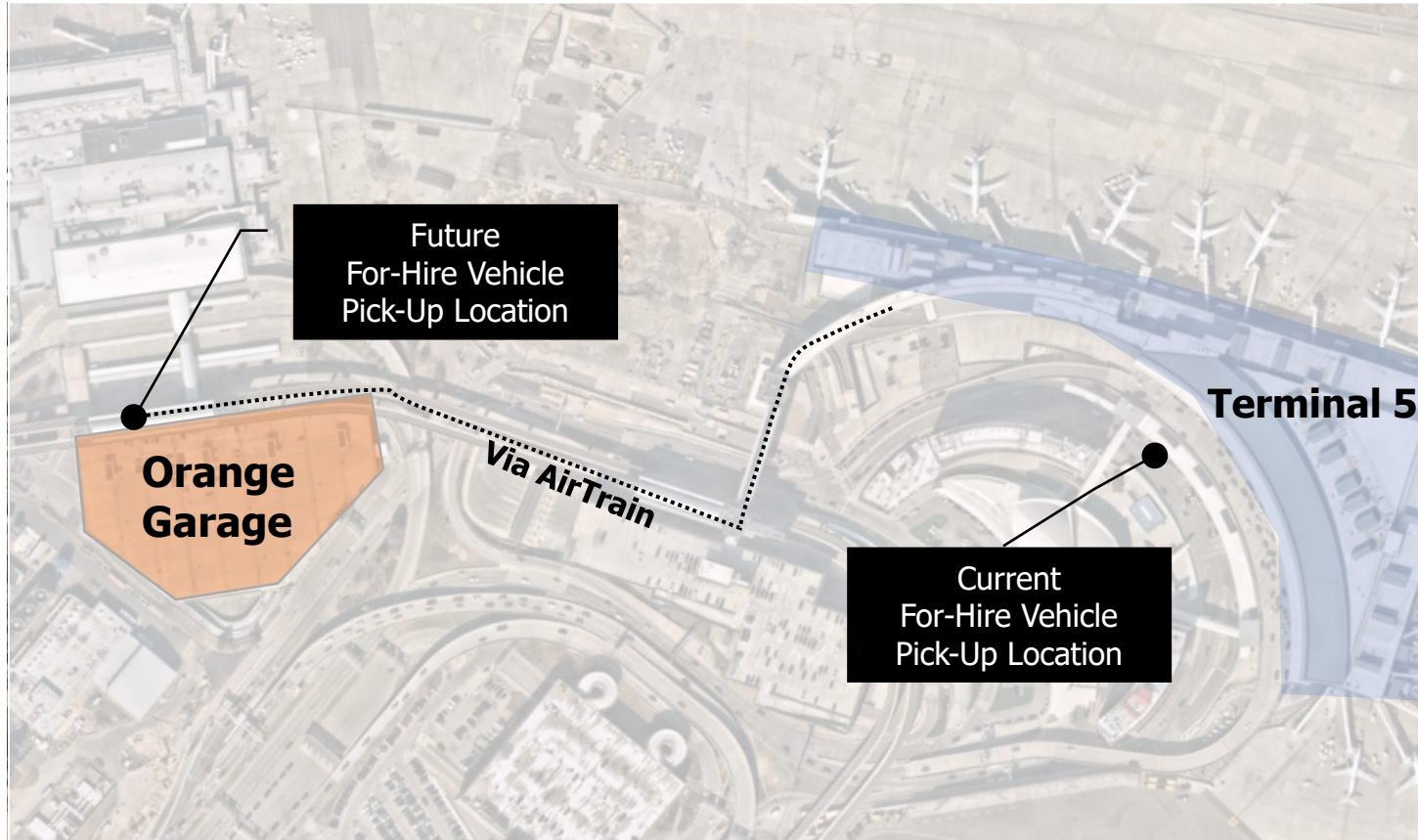
## Terminal 5 | Taxi Changes



- Taxi stand moving to ground level of Yellow Garage due to Terminal 6 construction
- Starts tomorrow, Wednesday April 26



# Terminal 5 | Upcoming For-Hire Vehicle Pick-Up Changes




- Terminal 5 for-hire vehicle pick-ups to move to Orange Garage roof due to Terminal 6 construction
- Activation Date: Early Summer 2023
- Convenient access for customers from the Terminal 7 AirTrain station
- No changes for departing customers



## What Travelers Need To Know

---

### Avoid traffic and take public transit

- JFK AirTrain (via Jamaica or Howard Beach)
- LIRR or subway are both options
- JFK AirTrain is 20 minutes from Penn or Grand Central via LIRR
- Subway connects to AirTrain via 
- JFK AirTrain located on LIRR main line, providing direct access from all Long Island Rail Road stations

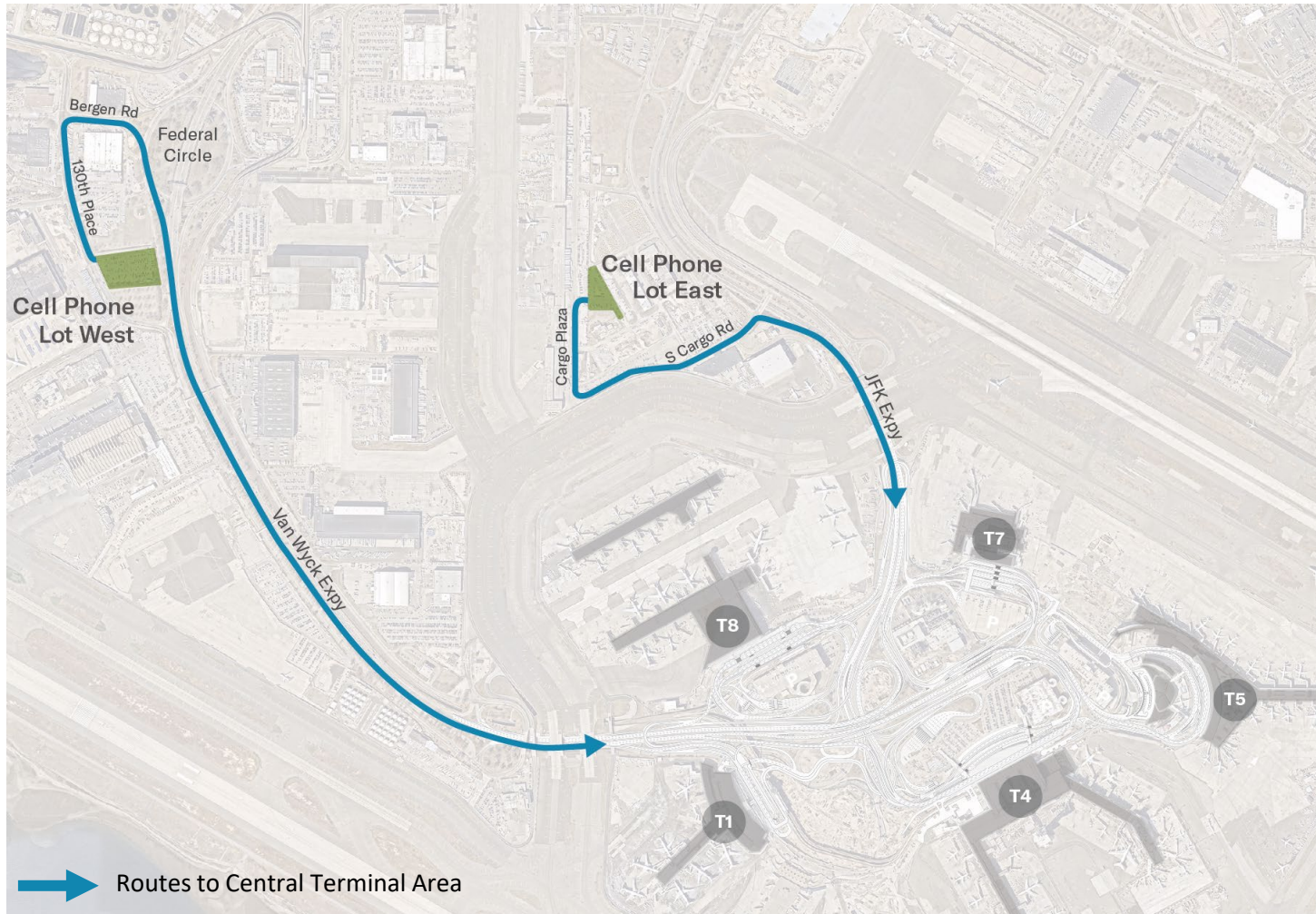
## What Travelers Need To Know
