Program Update

At our last meeting on March 5, which was pre-Covid-19, we presented a timeline that showed an expected JFK Redevelopment environmental assessment approval in Q1 or Q2 2020. We received the Record of Decision/Finding of No Significant Impact from the FAA on April 21. A notice of availability was published in local newspapers and sent to the Advisory Council on April 24. **That is good news.** It means that these projects may proceed, from a legal, regulatory point of view.

Also during that March 5th meeting, we announced that two of the JFK Redevelopment terminal deals were expected to close in Q2 2020, with construction starting shortly thereafter. But within days of that meeting, as we all know, the Covid-19 crisis struck the region, the nation, and the world. We are now at the end of the second quarter, and neither of those two terminal deals have closed yet. At this time, we are uncertain when they will close. The coronavirus has had a devastating impact on the entire aviation industry and the Port Authority. The agency's revenues have fallen precipitously due to dramatic declines in passenger volume across all our facilities airports, bridges & tunnels, PATH, etc. Due to the impacts of the pandemic, the Port Authority's entire capital plan is under review. Any project that was not already under construction before Covid-19 is being reevaluated. The impact of the Covid crisis has also affected the business plans of each project. The Port Authority is in discussion with each of the developers about the internal dynamics of each project. Additionally, the Port Authority is seeking federal assistance to help stabilize agency finances, in ways that would bolster the agency's ability to keep capital projects moving forward. We are working with the NY & NJ congressional delegation and stakeholders across the region to secure \$3 billion in direct federal funding. Congressman Meeks is a strong supporter of these efforts, and we are grateful to him. We will keep the Advisory Council up-to-date about the projects in the JFK Redevelopment program as the agency goes through its review.

Port Authority RFQS for General Construction Services on a Work-Order Basis

PANYNJ intends to maintain a roster of pre-qualified firms to perform general construction services. To that end, the agency seeks to award and execute multiple Master Agreements (or "Contracts") for general construction services on a Work Order Basis. Only firms that have an executed Master Agreement will receive requests for bids for future Work Orders. (Note: execution of a Master Agreement does not guarantee that a firm will be awarded a Work Order.)

Work Orders issued under these Master Agreements include:

- Demolition
- Abatement
- · Structural Steel & Concrete
- Plumbing
- HVAC
- Electrical
- Fireproofing
- General Site Work

Firms may submit qualifications for one or more of the ranges below. Total amount of work to be awarded under all Work Orders is estimated to be between \$100 and \$200 million.

- •Range A: up to \$2.5 million
- •Range B: \$2.5 to \$25 million
- •Range C: greater than \$25 million

RFQS will be available by July 10, 2020.
